This play is based on the popular song, "The Arkansas Traveler," written by Colonel Sanford Faulkner in the 1850s. Set in the Arkansas Ozarks, audiences will journey through Arkansas history and folklore as a traveler stumbles across an old cabin deep in the woods where he meets an old man and his wife. The traveler is invited to stay and enjoy fiddle music and storytelling on the porch. The old man tells a variety of stories that depict Arkansas' early pioneer history and wild frontier.
