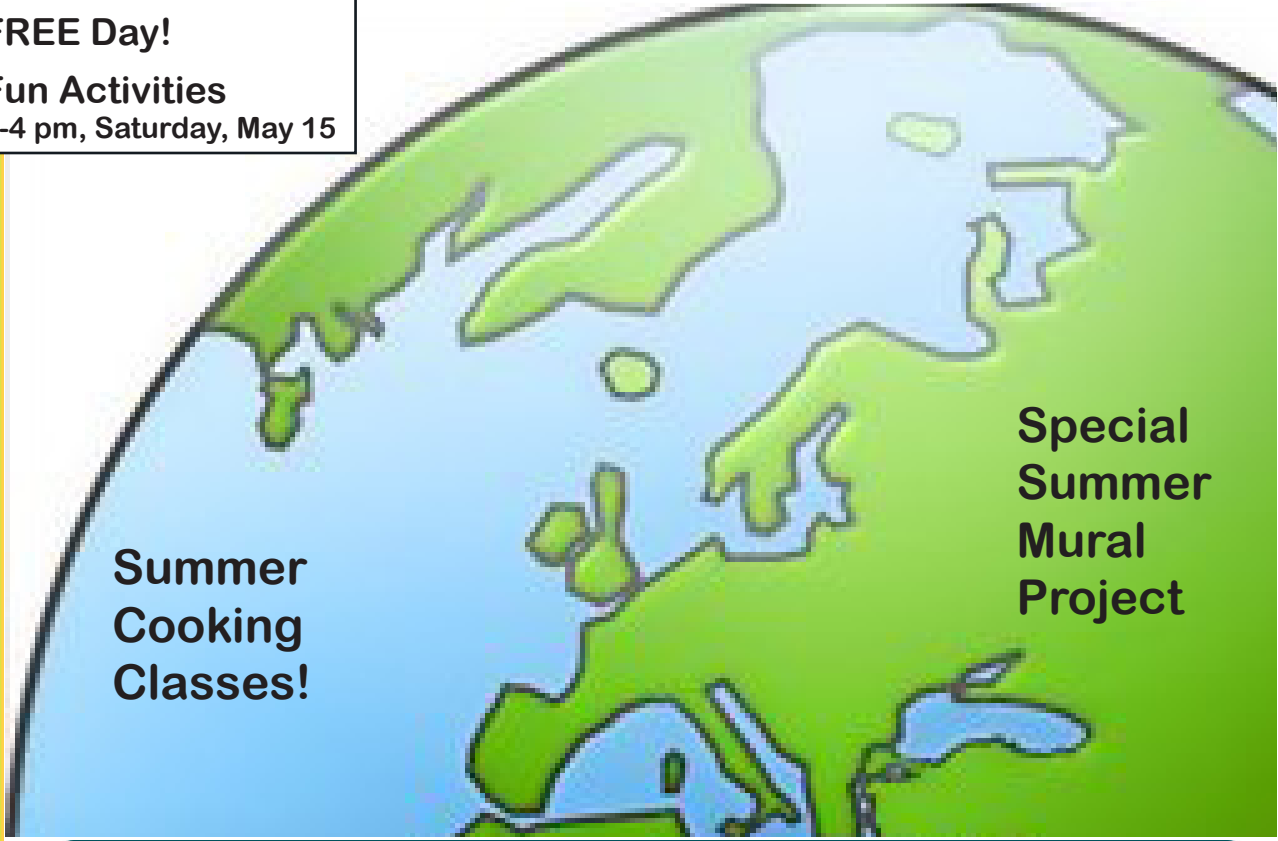

The Arts & Science Center for Southeast Arkansas holds its annual exhibition featuring the artwork of talented students from Pine Bluff High School. This year's theme is *ZebrArt Safari*.

William Detmers: **Recent Prints** May 5-June 27

The exhibit features original prints by William Detmers, University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff printmaking professor. Detmers creates mixed media prints combining imagery from his etchings with manipulated digital imagery. The results are visionary perspectives and dreamlike landscapes.

New Acquisitions

The ASC Board of Trustees has accepted four new artworks into the Permanent Collection. Included are two artworks by Robyn Horn; sculpture *541 Figured Texture*, box elder wood, and painting *267 Already Set in Motion*, acrylic on paper. Both artworks were in Horn's recent exhibition. Also accepted were a painting by Janis Gill Ward, *One Keeper, Two Throwaways*, mixed media watercolor on paper, and a painting by Marlene Gremillion, *Zinnia*, watercolor on paper. Ward and Gremillion also have had exhibitions at the Center. We wish to thank the artists for their generous gifts.

Educational **Programming** **Rules and Regulations**

The Arts & Science Center's Education Department provides unique learning experiences for individuals of all ages, especially for those interested in learning. Pre-registration is required for each class and must be made at least one week before class starts. If expected attendance is not reached, it could potentially be cancelled. Our classes are based on attendance; we offer no refunds or program swapping.

Eligibility:

All are welcome to attend our education programs. To register, complete the attached form and return it with payment to The Arts & Science Center before the registration deadline for each class. Class sizes are limited!

Fees:

Unless otherwise noted, the program fees can be found on the registration form. Non-members will receive a single membership with the purchase of a class. An individual is not considered "enrolled" for a program until payment is received. The tuition for Saturday Scholars and summer camps covers a light snack for children. Please feed your child before bringing them.

Financial Aid

The Arts & Science Center would like everyone to be able to participate in our education programs. When available, we will try to offer some form of financial aid on a first-come, first-served basis. Aid is based on family income and covers part of the registration fee. Applications can be picked up at the Center, printed from our website, mailed or faxed to you by calling 870-536-3375.

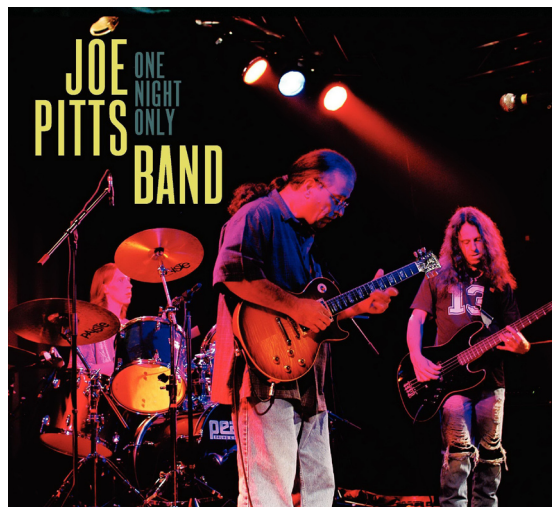
